STATION CHURCH IS COMING HOME!

Station Church dreams of being a movement of influencers, innovators, and world-changers, transforming our community through the Gospel.

Our GOAL is to develop life-long followers of Jesus.

Our **Vision** and **Goal** are the same, but our experience will be different.

The Station Church staff established our **Coming Home** plan based on recommendations from the CDC, Federal, State, and Local reopening guidelines, as well as reopening recommendations from the NY Ministry Network.

At Station Church we desire to implement "Best Practices," not the bare minimum. We aim to provide a safe and healthy environment for all people to experience the presence of God while in community with our Station Family!

Here's how you can help us as we **COME HOME**:

Medical Screenings

Before entering our facility, you will be greeted at our **Welcome Tent.** There you will be checked in to our Sunday Experience and medically screened with a temperature check and 3 questions.

In accordance with Federal and State guidelines, no record will be kept of your medical screening.

Masks

Masks will be required while entering and exiting Station Church, as well as when you are moving around the facility. Masks may be removed while you are seated in the Sanctuary.

Station Church staff and volunteers will wear masks at all times with the exception of those who will remove their masks while ministering from the stage. We understand that there are exceptions for babies/toddlers and those who are medically unable to tolerate face coverings.

Social Distancing

Please observe social distancing while in our facility. Our Sanctuary has been arranged to allow for six feet of separation between household units. We ask that you refrain from sitting with individuals who do not live in your household.

We understand that there are areas of the building that make it difficult to maintain six feet of separation, this is why it is important to wear a mask while moving through our facility.

Greeting

In order to reduce movement around our facility and to maintain social distancing guidelines, our "meet and greet" has been removed from our Sunday Experience. We ask that you **greet each other with a wave** in lieu of a hug, handshake, high five or fist bump.

Sanitation

Please make use of the automatic hand sanitizing stations that have been installed throughout our facility. You will find new hand hygiene signs installed in all of our restrooms. We encourage frequent hand washing as the preferred method of hand sanitation.

Giving

At this time, we encourage everyone to continue giving online. This ensures as "touch-free" of an experience as possible. For those who are unable to give online, our Giving Station will be

located in the back of the Sanctuary. You can fill out an offering envelope and drop your offering in the Giving Station.

What about my kids?

As we stated before, we are aiming for **Best Practices**, not the bear minimum when it comes to safety and sanitation. With that in mind, we are excited to announce that **Station Kids will be open.** throughout Station Kids, we will be able to continue providing a safe, fun, and engaging environment for our kids to learn about being life-long followers of Jesus! Please follow the instructions of our Station Kids staff and volunteers for guidance on dropping off and picking up your children from Station Kids.

Parents can help our Station Kids staff and volunteers by having conversations with your children about the importance of wearing their masks when not sitting down as well as teaching your children how to greet everyone with a wave instead of a hug, high five, or fist bump.
